From The Pastor

BELIEVER BEWARE!

A couple of weeks ago, I stumbled across a documentary called "American Gospel: In Christ Alone" which addresses and opposes the increasingly popular false teachers in the American Church. Now, this is not a hit piece or an expose filled with accusations and innuendo. Rather, it features faithful Christian pastors and teachers who carefully explain the true Gospel proclaimed in the Scriptures and contrast it with the "American Gospel" that is boldly and widely proclaimed on TV, in books, and even in our pulpits every Sunday.

That there should be so many false teachers and abusers in the Church is indeed troubling, but it should not be shocking. Jesus Himself and the Apostles continually warned believers to be on their guard lest they be led astray. Here are just a few of their warnings:

- Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. (Matt. 7:15)
- I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things to draw away the disciples after them. (Acts 20:29-30)
- Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. So it is no surprise if his servants, also, disguise themselves as servants of righteousness. (2 Corinthians 11:14-15)
- False prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them. (2 Peter 2:1)
- It is the last hour, and as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come. (1 John 2:18)
- Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world. (1 John 4:1)

HOW TO RECOGNIZE FALSE TEACHERS

If we are to stay true to Christ and His Word, we must be able to recognize and rebuke (or at least run from) these false prophets. The Scriptures mentioned above give us two basic tests:

- 1.We can know them by their TEACHING or more accurately by what they will NOT be preaching. Though they may mention Jesus' name and open their bibles, they are always taking the Bible out of context (just like the Devil himself Matthew 4) and the center and focus of their preaching is *not* Jesus Christ as the only Lord and Savior who died and rose again to save us from our sins. This is why they are called "anti-Christs".
- 2.We will know them by their LIFESTYLE (FRUIT). They are of the world...according to 1 John: full of lust, pride and greed (1 John 2:15-17). They pursue power, wealth and pleasure at the expense of their listeners. (Which is what you would expect when you hire wolves to to tend the sheep.)

There is a lot more to say about this matter, and, God willing, we will look more closely in the coming months. As a start, we have received permission to show the American Gospel documentary at the church free of charge. Since it is over 2 hours long, we will view it over 3 Sunday evenings which will leave us time for reflection and discussion. If you are a believer in Christ or have any interest at all in what the Bible truly teaches, then please join us. This will be well worth your time. Here is the schedule:
